## FORD GRANADA Mk I

Successor to the Mk IV Zodiac, Ford launched the Granada in 1972. This new model was also the replacement for the German Taunus models. An impressive and well-proportioned car, the new Granada was enthusiastically received, being available in 2, 2½ and 3-litre versions.



A 1976 example, the Granada presented here has a recorded mileage of 57,700, which is believed by the vendor to be genuine. It has been owned by a film company vehicle supplier and has made numerous screen appearances including *Top Gear*, *Men and Motors* and a recent tribute to the late John Thaw shown on BBC 3, to mention just a few. It is also due to feature in several new films yet to be released, namely *The Line of Beauty, Starter for Ten*, plus a Vodafone advertisement.

Finished in metallic gold with black interior trim, the car is of very smart appearance and is said to be mechanically in good order throughout and to drive exceptionally well. Sumptuously equipped, the Granada offered excellent value for money and this now rare example of the Mk I is sure to create interest.
